Big Al's is committed to ensuring a FUN, safe & rewarding environment for our guests and staff. The following CODE OF CONDUCT and DRESS CODE allow us to maintain that promise for the greater good.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Any persons requesting to consume alcoholic beverages must produce a valid, state or government-issued identification card which includes, but is not limited to: date of birth, photo, height, eye color, and sex. Any ID that is damaged, apparently altered, or expired is not acceptable as a valid form of ID. Outside alcoholic beverages and consumption by minors is prohibited. 100 oz. Beer Tubes require a minimum of three (3) guests.

Big Al's also prohibits smoking inside the building, and only in clearly designated areas outside. Cigars, vaporizers, e-cigarettes, and chewing tobacco are similarly prohibited inside of Big Al's.

Big Al's also prohibits the following behaviors:

- Bringing in outside food or beverages;
- Consuming your own alcohol in the parking lot or within our building (if caught you will be subject to trespassing);
- Threatening or using physical force, obscene gestures or racial, religious or ethnic slurs, or any other explicit language;
- Damaging or destroying any real or personal property;
- Instigating a fight or altercation (if caught you will be subject to trespassing);
- Soliciting or loitering in the building or in common outside areas, including the parking lot;
- Bringing in animals, except those for Service needs;
- Carrying any weapon of any kind, unless lawfully permitted.

DRESS CODE

Big Al's reserves the right to refuse entry to guests who are not dressed appropriately for a family-friendly environment. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Clothing deemed "intimate" or that exposes underwear or excessive skin, as well as excessively torn or dirty attire;
- Clothing or accessories that display offensive language or graphics or that are considered evidence of gang attire, including colors or imagery, real or implied;
- Inappropriate headwear, excluding straight front-facing or backwards baseball caps, casual caps or religious headwear as defined by federal & local law.
